

End-to-end archiving solutions from NeoFinder and Datainer.

The latest version (7.1.3) of NeoFinder – for years one of the most remarkable professional media management solutions on the Mac – now also offers 2D barcode-based catalogue data management and printing.

The contents of media (hard disks, SSDs, flashcards...) can now be printed as scannable barcodes and plain text on widely available labels applied to the media, thus turning piles of anonymous hard disks, etc. into easily browsable media libraries.

Datainer represents the practical “hardware environment”: this modular, expandable storage system provides safe, secure and easy-access storage for virtually all media formats – and it’s barcode compatible: the barcode labels can be scanned through the translucent front flaps.

The icing on the cake for users of the latest version (iOS 1.9) of NeoFinder for iPhone and iPad is the ability to scan barcodes and instantly display the contents of catalogued media: this saves time locating films, images, documents and other data.

Windows users will soon be benefiting from a similar solution called abeMeda.
